There are Bloodhounds with the Arizona Basset Breed Rescue group in Gilbert/Phoenix area that need adoption. We refer any potential homes to them or to the online application process. <http://www.azbassetrescue.com/> or 602-225-7800 or 866-882-9247.

We still have several dogs with the original owners that BHW Rescue is referring due to our over crowding/population.

All dogs from Bloodhounds West Rescue, Inc. are updated on their shots unless we have records from a hospital indicating current vaccinations. We give Rabies, DHLPP, Bordetella, heartworm test, microchips (unless already chipped), hips and elbows x-rayed and a complete health screening. Fecals and deworming are done. If the dogs are already altered, we don't x-ray unless we suspect problems and/or the new owner requests it and it is added to the adoption fee. Our adoption fee is \$250. Much of the medical/treatment/medicine cost is donated by Canyon Animal Hospital.

Year old **Asher** and 6 month old **Fiddler** have been adopted, Stacy has adopted **Belle** who is a wonderful dog and sadly, **Maya** age 2 or 3 has died of cancer.

Available for Adoption:

Abigail is a 5-8 yr old black/tan spayed female. She's overweight and not very active but good around other dogs.

Rusty is a 5 yr old red neutered male, and good with other dogs and "has a husky voice because I'm debarked ...I'm a great watch dog."

Abigail and **Rusty** were seized by the County of Riverside Animal Control, their owner was being cited for cruelty/abuse/animal hoarding in June 2007.

Lucky is a 2 yr old black and tan bitch, 85 lbs, plays well with other dogs, owner relinquished due to lack of knowledge. She will do well with an active family/lifestyle with strong leadership skills.

Reeses Pieces in a foster home. He is an 6-8 yr old black/tan neutered male who has had a rough life after having his ledgs bitten by other animals and his ear ripped. He could use donatins for his hip surgery.

Rose Justice is a 12+ yr old, spayed red who is staying at Stacy's but she could use a sponsor.

Emerson "I have been here forever...I'm as old as the hills and as gentle as a summer breeze." **Emerson** is staying at Stacy's but he could use a sponsor.



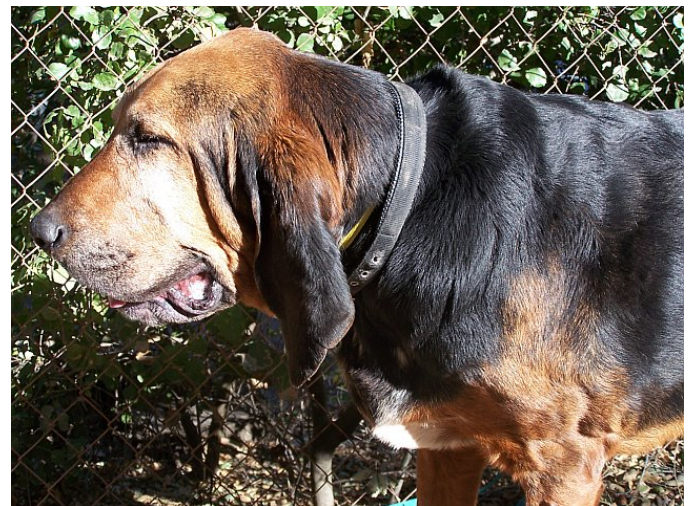

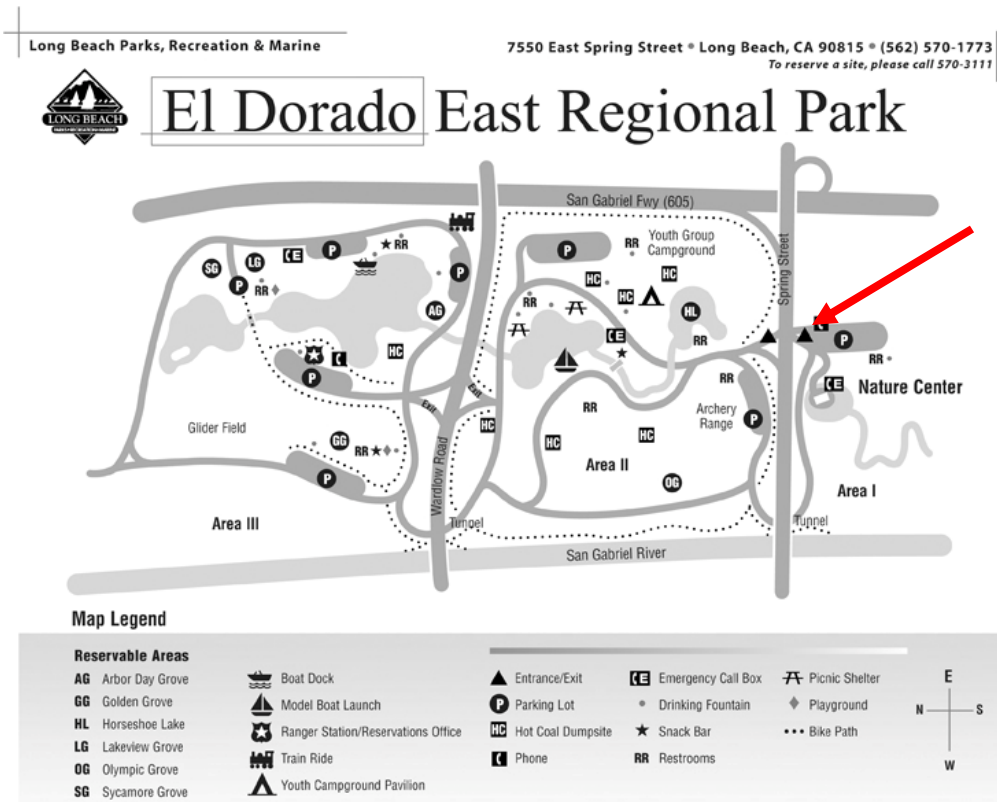

June 14, 2007

Dear Bloodhounds West, Northern Chapter,

My name is Kirby. Some of you know me, most of you don't. I hold a Master Poop Scooper classification from the operating engineers union. The manager(s) of the pet store(s) where I buy dog food love me. The question I am most asked, How many dogs you got today?

When I attend a dog show, as at home, I am the stable boy for my other half. I haul around slobber rags, spray bottles and cool coats. I can be heard on the receiving end of conversations that include, Hold this one. Take her and give me him. Take him and give me her. Where's? You WHAT? What did you do with? Where's the arm band? And, WHAT TOOK YOU SO LONG?

I can be seen day or night escorting hounds up and down elevators, stairways, corridors, walking through grass, bushes, trees and truck stops, plastic bag(s) in hand, most often babbling to myself things I cant say here. I am the one that stays awake at night because one of the hounds convinces the others there exists a verbal mission of great urgency, has a urge to sniff the bushes, or thinks my bed is their bed and sharing is out of the question. The last motel visit involved two twin size beds and a hounds belief that leaping gazelles were in the bloodline.

I have been taking photos of bloodhound for over 15 years. I go to the shows to visit the dogs more than anything else. I renew old friendships with certain hounds and develop new relationships with others. My photographic goal is to capture the majestic movement, personality, and nobility, of not only the animal, but of the people that show them.

This was the second Hollister event I have attended. I am at a loss to describe the degree of enjoyment I experienced. I took approximately 800 photos and was allowed to scratch and pet a number of beautiful animals (the best part of it knowing I did not have to feed them).

I want to thank Tim and Sherry, and their club, for allowing us to be a part of the celebration of life we call the Bloodhound. It is because of them, and other dedicated people, that I don't pin a \$5 McDonalds coupon on each of our hounds and send them out the front door with the words, Come back when you have rent money.

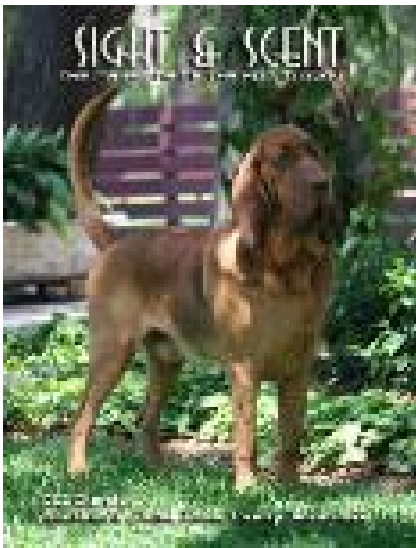

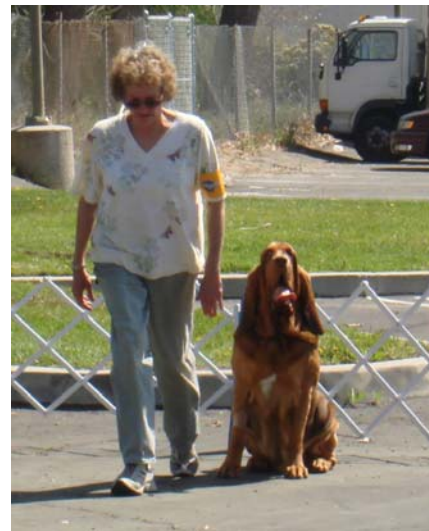
